



# CONFERENCE DETAILS

## PREPARING FOR THE MAIN EVENT



### REGISTRATION

The pre-registration deadline is **Monday, June 2**. To qualify for the pre-registration rates listed below, registration forms *and* fees must be submitted by this date.

If your group registers by or before June 2 and **requests accommodations in one of our conference hotels**, your registration fees are as follows:

- \$150 per Youth Delegate
- \$100 per Sponsor

If your group registers by or before June 2 and **requests accommodations in one of our \*dormitories**, your registration fees are as follows:

- \$135 per Youth Delegate
- \$100 per Sponsor

*\*by request and based upon availability*

If your group registers by or before June 2 and **will not require accommodations**, meaning that you will secure your own lodgings, your registration fees are as follows:

- \$85 per Youth Delegate
- \$85 per Sponsor

#### **\*\*IMPORTANT\*\***

**Groups registering after June 2 and requiring accommodations** will be asked either to stay in the dormitories, pending availability, or to secure their own accommodations for the week.

To qualify for the sponsor rate, a chaperone must be eighteen years of age or older.

Please contact the church offices to confirm receipt of all registration forms and fees.

**All registration fees increase by \$10 after June 2.** Please keep in mind that registration is incomplete without registration forms *and* fees. For example, you may submit your registration forms on June 2 to confirm group accommodations; but without accompanying registration fees, your group would incur late registration charges.

**Registration will be held on the second level of the Cristina Martinez Commons Building on the campus of Golden State Baptist College on Monday, June 16**, from 3:00 P.M. to 6:00 P.M. and then following the evening service. Materials for the week—conference booklets, team assignments, group t-shirts, room keys (for groups staying in a conference hotel or dormitory), *etc.*—will be distributed at registration.

### GUIDELINES

Please keep in mind throughout the week of the conference that we are guests of the establishments listed above and that we must conduct ourselves in an appropriate, exemplary manner befitting our faith and practice.

1. **Your delegation must be properly supervised at all times.** You will read in the official conference brochure that North Valley Baptist Church requires one worker to be assigned to every eight teenagers. Every group that brings both young ladies and young men must have at least one male youth worker and one female youth worker. The safety and well-being of your young people is paramount.
2. **Please be considerate and mindful** not only of personnel and other guests within each hotel or dormitory but also of the buildings and properties of each establishment. Please do not run in the hallways, play loud music, bring any animals or pets, and conduct or take part in any other activities that may disrupt other guests or cause damage to any items or buildings owned by each establishment.
3. **North Valley Baptist Church security personnel** in the hotels and dormitories are there to answer any questions you may

have about our guidelines as well as any related conference matters and to help maintain a good testimony for all our delegates. We ask that you please inform your young people to heed their instructions.

4. **When staying in one of our dormitories**, we ask that you please follow these simple guidelines:
  - No food or gum is allowed in any of the dormitories.
  - No video games and similar media are allowed.
  - Please leave your keys in your rooms prior to leaving on Thursday morning.
  - Maintenance crews will begin cleaning the dormitories about **thirty minutes after the closing service**. All rooms should be vacated by this time.
5. **North Valley Baptist Church will not be held responsible** for any injury, damage, or theft that may occur during the conference. Money or personal items should never be left unattended.

## AFTERNOON EXCURSIONS

The cost of tickets for the afternoon conference activities on Tuesday (California's Great America) and Wednesday (San Francisco Giants vs. Detroit Tigers) is included in the registrations fees.

**Tickets for the events will be distributed on the mornings of the actual activities in the lobby of the church building.** On Tuesday morning, tickets will be distributed for the Great America activity; on Wednesday morning, tickets will be distributed for the baseball game. Pastors and youth pastors, please pick up tickets for all registered delegates in your groups during one of the times listed below. (Choosing the earlier time will allow your groups to board the buses as soon as the second services are dismissed.)

1. Before the First Morning Service (7:00 - 7:50 A.M.)
2. After the Second Morning Service

Tickets will not be distributed individually. For example, the pastor or youth pastor of Baptist Church A must pick up all the tickets for his youth group and cannot send individual delegates to collect their tickets.

**PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE THE PROPERTY WITHOUT YOUR TICKETS.**

## ANNUAL BIBLE QUIZ

**The Annual Bible Quiz will cover the book of Colossians.** Match schedules will be posted throughout the week of the conference.

The maximum number of teams per church is two, and every team must have four young people. (Please note that a young person may only be on one team. For example, John Smith of Team 1 from Baptist Church A may not also be on Team 2 from the same church.)

Groups may sign up for the Annual Bible Quiz on the Group Registration Form.

## MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION

- The conference is open to those in sixth through twelfth grade.
- There must be at least one worker for every eight teenagers.
- Every group that brings both young ladies and young men must have at least one male youth worker and one female youth worker.
- Young ladies are required to wear knee-length skirts or dresses, and young men must wear slacks and collared shirts to all services and sessions. Young ladies may wear modest culottes during activity times—no pants, please.
- Nurseries will not be provided.
